Why Volunteer?

Hundreds of young women in your own community are faced with the frightening diagnosis of breast cancer every day. These women have young families, careers and commitments. They find themselves thrust into a cycle of doctor appointments, treatments and increasing pressures of life and often do not know where to turn.

In The Pink Foundation, Inc. provides a place for young breast cancer survivors and their loved ones to come participate in programs, just relax, interact with others, and/or gather resources. ITPF's support group is designed to help young women deal with the emotional aspects of having cancer. The group also serves to provide peer support, guidance, and information. The group membership represents a diverse population with differences in ethnicity, types of breast cancer, and life circumstances. ITPF also provides other programs such as: intake/referral services, therapeutic and wellness groups (nutrition, art, yoga, music, strengthening and stretching), child and family activities.
